Kim Reale has skated all her life. She is a United States Double Gold Medalist in Figures and Freestyle. She has her Silvers in Dance. She won a gold medal in the 1975 North Atlantic Novice Ladies Regional Championships and got silver in both Junior and Senior Ladies Championships in 77, 78, and 1980. She competed in the United States and Canada for 11 years before a stress fracture ended her competitive career.

Kim has taught on and off for 20 years and for the past 5 years teaching full time. She has brought children up from basics up through the preliminary level. She teaches Moves in the Field and Freestyle, Jumps, Spins, Choreography and Stroking.

Kim's career began at 4 and a half years of age and started competing at age 9. She was a member of the illustrious Skating Club of New York. She has studied with internationally known coaches Peter Dunfield, Fritz Deitel, Hans Gershweiler, Donald Laws and Tommy Litz.

Kim studied Pilates in the original studio with world renowned Romana Kryzanowska. She studied ballet with Alvin Ailey and, the Broadway Dance Center. She has also studied Jazz with Phil Black, Pepsi Bethel, and Jose Limon.

Kim's professional experience has varied greatly. She skated in shows for over 25 years. When she retired from performing she worked backstage with the famous Cirque du Soleil doing everything from painting the shoes to and head pieces to styling the wigs for the show.

Kim is a member of the USFS, ISI, and PSA. She has her BA rating.
